



These qualities give wool a wide and diverse range of uses.



What Is RWS Wool?

The Responsible Wool Standard (RWS) addresses environmental challenges in traditional wool production. From sheep rearing to textile processing, wool production has significant environmental impacts that call for sustainable solutions. RWS certification ensures wool comes from farms practicing responsible land management and animal care, promoting sustainable sourcing to meet the growing demand for eco-friendly products

Animal welfare

The Five Freedoms of animal welfare are incorporated into the criteria for the Responsible Wool Standard.

Land health

Progressive methods of land management are checked on certified farms to help protect soil health, biodiversity, and native species.

Social welfare

The standard criteria also cover social welfare, working conditions, and the health and safety of workers associated with farms.

Credible certification

A professional, third-party certification body audits each stage in the supply chain starting at the farm.

Chain of custody

Certification helps to maintain the identity of wool from certified farms through to final products. Learn more.

Confident communication

Products that meet the minimum requirements for certification may be labeled with the Responsible Wool Standard logo.

This that serves to confirm our 1/14Nm and 2/14Nm Lamaine yarns - International Commodity code HSC No. 51061090- have been manufactured in Scotland – United Kingdom using 100% RWS superfine lambswool fibre – HSC No. 51052100, type Ovis Aries Aries species of Domestic Rearing (common name Merino Sheep) produced and collected in South Africa or Australia in an ethical and responsible manner- complying with CITES, Californium Proposition 65 and all European Specifications, namely restrictions on AZO and Nickel containing dyes and Chromium VI.

The yarns are compliant with the EU Directive 1907/2006 on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), meaning that:

- · Our yarns are categorized as "articles" under the REACH Regulations.
- It is not intended that our yarns release substances during normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions of use.
- Regarding the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) candidate list, Todd and Duncan yarns do not contain more than 0.1% by weight per article of any substance on the SVHC candidate list.

We will continue to monitor the status of the candidate list as part of our on-going compliance activities, including the possible need under Article 33 of REACH to inform product recipients and consumers if an article contains more than 0.1% by weight per article of any substance that is added to the SVHC candidate list in the future.

Further to that we confirm that the yarns meet strict standards comparable to the requirements set for Oeko tex 100 Class II (materials to be used next to the skin) and People's Republic of China general safety standard for textiles GB 18401 -2010 with regards to materials to be used with direct skin contact





SS11 Soft Shetland itself this is spun from 25 micron non-mulesed fibre which is sourced from New Zealand.

As a little history about us, we are Brierley Brothers who trade as Gardiner Yarns. We are a traditional woollen yarn spinner based in Huddersfield and have been manufacturing here on this site since the mid-19th century. We make woollen (carded) spun stock supported coloured mixture yarn ranges supplied in oil on cone for knitwear and weaving.

We spin our yarns from wools that are ethically sourced from producers that follow internationally accepted husbandry guidelines. All our yarn ranges (including our Lambswool range) are mulesing free as the countries that supply the wools do not practice this procedure. Following a recent audit, we are now a RWS Certified producer (licence Number CB-CUC- 1326440),


